

SUPERINTENDENT'S CONTRACT

The Attleboro School Committee, upon the appointment of a candidate will enter into a written contract with the Superintendent that will meet the requirements of law and will protect the rights of both the School Committee and the Superintendent. The Officers of the School Committee (comprised of the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, and Secretary) will negotiate with the Superintendent a contract that will be presented to the School Committee for approval based on the parameters set by the School Committee.

In accordance with said contract or, in the absence of specific contract language, by vote of the members, the Committee may choose to negotiate a successor contract with an incumbent Superintendent.

NOTE: Under the laws of the Commonwealth, the School Committee may award a contract to a Superintendent of Schools for a period not to exceed six years.
