GOLDEN AGE PASS

In recognition of the contributions made to the education of students by senior citizens and in order to encourage their participation in school activities, the Attleboro School Committee establishes the following policy:

- Senior citizens 65 years of age or older who are residents of Attleboro shall be allowed free entry to any school activity (excluding MIAA-run-tournaments; Hockomock-League run-events; and the Thanksgiving Day Football Games).
- Senior citizens 55 years of age or older who are residents of Attleboro shall be allowed to participate in any and all adult education classes with a 10% discount on the tuition costs and a waiver of the registration fee. Any nominal fees for supplies would be the responsibility of the participant.

To obtain a Senior Gold Card, please contact the Office of the Superintendent at 100 Rathbun Willard Drive, during normal business hours. Proof of age and residency must be shown in order to obtain a Golden Age Pass (that is valid for life).
