EMPLOYEE CHILD CARE PROGRAM

Attleboro Public Schools will provide full-day child care services. Application for enrollment of children ranging in ages from six (6) weeks up to kindergarten eligibility will be considered based on the order received and dependent on space availability. However, the infant children of Attleboro High School students have priority over the children of school employees, children of city employees, children of Attleboro residents in the allocation of available seats.

The forum for this service will be the Children's Center at Attleboro High School, which serves as the lab environment for the students enrolled in the Chapter 74 approved Early Education and Care Program. The student to staff ratio within the program will meet state DEEC guidelines.

The child care service is available, provided the Children's Center is funded and has seats available. Details about the program, including fees, hours of operation, and application procedures shall be outlined in the *Children's Center Parent Handbook*. Enrollment forms may be obtained by contacting Attleboro High School.

Families with children enrolled in the program will receive bi-weekly invoices. Families who fall more than one payment cycle into arrears will be notified that they must make alternate arrangements for their child(ren) until they have paid their balance in full. A fee will be charged when the child(ren) is (are) reinstated to the program.
