Enrollment of Children of Non-Resident Staff Policy

File: JFA

An employee of the Attleboro Public Schools may enroll his or her child, provided the employee maintains legal custody of the child, in the Attleboro Public Schools subject to the following restrictions and qualifications.

Enrollment in the Attleboro Public Schools of a child of an APS employee who does not reside in Attleboro shall be subject to approval by, and at the sole discretion of, the Superintendent. The Superintendent's decision to allow or deny enrollment under this policy shall not exceed any one academic year and may not be appealed to the School Committee.

The Superintendent shall take the following factors into account when reviewing an application for enrollment under this policy, although none shall be considered automatically determinative:

1. Best interests of the applicant student.
2. Capacity of the receiving school to admit an additional student at the student's specific grade level.
3. An intent by the non-resident staff member to obtain Attleboro residency.
4. A student's previous residency in Attleboro and enrollment in the Attleboro schools.
5. The length of APS service of the non-resident staff member.

Applications for enrollment under this policy must be received by the Superintendent by May 1st of the previous academic year.
