- Provide a consistent, well lit, quiet area for learning, and seated at a table/desk or near a flat surface.
- Encourage my child's effort and support his/her learning.
- Read with my child, listen to my child read and let my child see me read.
- Encourage my child to respect peers during meetings, at school, and all staff.
- Become involved by attending parent conferences, PTO meetings, Title I workshops, and/or school activities.
