Dear Parents:

A daily breakfast is available at your child's school.

What is a school breakfast?

School breakfast is available to all students prior to the start of the school day. Students are offered 8 ounces of milk, 4 ounces of juice or a fruit and two servings of grain (such as hot and cold cereal, muffin, bagel, pancakes, waffles, etc.). The menu features eggs and grab and go items. The breakfast menu provides the nourishment your child needs to perform in the morning classes.

How much does breakfast cost?

The price of breakfast is \$1.00. Your child may also be eligible for a free or reduced price meal- any student who is eligible for a free or reduced price lunch can also receive a free or reduced price breakfast. The reduced price is \$0.30.

Why should my child eat breakfast at school?

Even though your child may not be hungry at home, a morning meal is still needed to supply adequate energy to carry him or her to lunch time. Studies have shown that students who eat breakfast perform better than those without a breakfast.

We urge and encourage all our students to take advantage of this valuable program.

Parents should be aware that each school breakfast and lunch program offers a pre payment feature to fund a student account. This allows the student to avoid carrying cash, speeds his way through the lunch line and gives parents the opportunity to designate how the funds should be spent. With a note or notation on the check, a parent may indicate the funds to be used for meals and/or snacks and in what ratio. Check payable to Attleboro Public Schools.
