### Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or a 504 Plan?

There are over 1,000 students receiving special education support services in the Attleboro School District. The Attleboro Special Education Parent Advisory Council (ASEPAC) is a group of parents whose children receive special education support services in the Attleboro Public Schools and Attleboro families with students in out of district placements. The Mission of our organization is:

- *To facilitate understanding, respect and support for all children with special education needs in our community.*

Whether a student is receiving special education services in a general education classroom, a substantially separate program, or an out of district program, ASEPAAC is an important resource for parents, guardians, teachers and special education support staff. Here is a listing of what ASEPAAC does:

- Provide monthly informational workshops to parents, guardians, educators, students and professionals
- Promote a network for parents and guardians of children with special education needs supported by Individualized Education Plans (IEP's) and 504 Accommodation Plans including Attleboro families with students in out of district placements
- Provide resources for parents and guardians who suspect their child has a learning disability
- Share information and resources via our monthly meetings and an email list serve
- Provide fun family events for students receiving special education services and their families
- Communicate ideas and concerns to the Director of Special Education and Student Support Services

Our monthly meetings are open to the public and often include parents and educators from surrounding communities. Monthly meetings are held for parent/guardian support from 6:30PM-7:00PM and a general meeting with parents/guardians and any interested school staff from 7:00-9:00PM. ASEPAC is committed to reaching out to all families in Attleboro. ASEPAC is seeking the assistance of all general education teachers, special education teachers, Team Chairs and school Principals to share our information with families of students receiving special education services via an IEP or a 504 plan.
